

## **X-Physique 2010 Frequently-Asked Questions**

### **Race Detail Enquiries:**

#### **1. When is X-Physique 2010?**

X-Physique 2010 will be on 16<sup>th</sup> May 2010.

#### **2. What is the starting venue and time of X-Physique 2010?**

Starting venue and time will be revealed at a later date. Details will be on the website and will also be provided during the Pre-Event Briefing day. Pre-Event Briefing will be scheduled on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2010. At least one member from the team must report for the Pre-Event Briefing with the respective matriculation card, student pass, NRIC or 11B for verification.

#### **3. What do we have to bring for the race?**

Exact details required for the race will be given during the Pre-Event Briefing. Pre-Event Briefing will be scheduled on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2010. At least one member from the team must report for the Pre-Event Briefing with the respective matriculation card, student pass, NRIC or 11B for verification.

#### **4. Do I have to provide my own racing equipment?**

Safety gears for any high elements will be provided by the organisers.

#### **5. Can I use my personal bicycle for the race?**

Yes, participants are strongly encouraged to use their personal **mountain bicycles**. However, those who do not wish to use their personal mountain bicycles have to rent mountain bicycles and helmets at an additional cost of S\$13.00.

#### **6. Will the race route be disclosed to the teams prior to the race?**

To ensure fairness and due to the nature of the race, the race route will not be disclosed to the participants until race day.

#### **7. Will the race route differ for the different categories?**

No, the race route will be the same for all categories.

### **Pre-Event Briefing Enquiries:**

#### **1. When is the Pre-Event Briefing?**

Pre-Event Briefing will be scheduled on 8<sup>th</sup> May 2010. The confirmed time and venue for the Pre-Event Briefing will be emailed to the various team leaders at least 1 week before the Pre-Event Briefing day.

#### **2. Where will the Pre-Event Briefing be held at?**

The confirmed time and venue for the Pre-Event Briefing will be emailed to the various team leaders at least 1 week before the Pre-Event Briefing day. The information will also be available on our website.

#### **3. Do all the team members need to attend the Pre-Event Briefing?**

Preferably, the whole team should attend the Pre-Event Briefing. However, if team members are unable to make it for the briefing, at least 1 member from each team must be present as important information will be given out.

#### **4. What do we have to bring for the Pre-Event Briefing?**

Please bring along your respective matriculation card, student pass, NRIC, 11B or other relevant documents for verification.

## **Team/Category Enquiries:**

### **1. Details of the different categories.**

- Junior College (JC) Shield

3 members from the same JC, with at least one team member of the opposite gender (e.g. 1 Male and 2 Females / 2 Males and 1 Female from the same JC)

- Inter-Varsity Challenge

3 members can be from different Varsities, with at least one team member of the opposite gender (e.g. 1 Male and 2 Females / 2 Males and 1 Female from any Universities, Polytechnics or ITEs)

- Mixed Open

3 members aged 16 and above as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010, with at least one team member of the opposite gender

(e.g. 1 Male and 2 Females / 2 Males and 1 Female)

- National Service Force Challenge

3 members who are in the National Service Force and all the team members must be male.

- Lovers' Challenge

A couple team which consists of a male and a female, with both members aged 16 and above as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010.

### **2. Team Information**

It is compulsory for each team to race with 3 members or 2 members (Lovers' Challenge).

It is compulsory to have a member of the opposite gender except for National Service Force Challenge.

### **3. Minimum Age Requirement**

Members have to be aged 16 and above as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 to be eligible to take part in the Mixed Open and Lovers' Challenge categories. Also, note that participants under the age of 21 as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 will need to fill in the indemnity form found in the Registration Form.

## **Registration Enquiries:**

### **1. Early Bird Registration Fee**

The early bird registration fee PER PAX for the Mixed Open, NSF Challenge and Lovers' Challenge categories is **S\$40.00**, exclusive of rental of mountain bicycles and helmets.

There will be no early bird registration fee for the Inter-Varsity Challenge and JC Shield. Registration fee PER PAX is **S\$40.00**.

\*An additional fee of **S\$13.00** will be required for the rental of both mountain bicycles and helmets. There will be no rental of either mountain bicycles or helmets individually.

### **2. Registration Fee**

The registration fee PER PAX for the Mixed Open, NSF Challenge and Lovers' Challenge categories is **S\$50.00**, exclusive of rental of mountain bicycles and helmets.

The registration fee PER PAX for the Inter-Varsity Challenge and JC Shield categories is **S\$40.00**, exclusive of mountain bicycles and helmets.

\*An additional fee of **S\$13.00** will be required for the rental of both mountain bicycles and helmets. There will be no rental of either mountain bicycles or helmets individually.

### **3. How do I register my team?**

The registration forms can be either be downloaded from our website or obtained from our booth in NTU. Each form must be completed with the particulars of every team member. The form can either reach us through snail-mail with a valid cheque or submitted to our booth.

#### **4. Where can I obtain a registration form?**

For JCs, registration forms are available from the Physical Education Department.

For NTU or NIE students or staff, registration forms are available from the booths which will be set up at both Canteen A and Canteen B.

Alternatively, you can download the Registration Form from our website.

#### **5. How do I submit my registration form and payment?**

Each team is required to submit only 1 Registration Form per team and 1 Health Declaration Form for each member. All team members have to fill in his/her particulars.

For snail mail submission of registration form, payment must be made via a cross cheque payable to NTU STUDENT UNION (**cash and cashier's orders are strictly not allowed**). Please also include a photocopy of your student card if you are registering for the Inter-Varsity Challenge or JC Shield. Please also include a photocopy of your 11B or other relevant documents if you are registering for the National Service Force Challenge.

OR:

Registration can be made directly at our booths in NTU with the registration form, health declaration forms and cash or cheque.

Deadline for all registration is **20<sup>th</sup> April 2010**.

**Please ensure that all particulars are filled in. Any blanks or incorrect information will cause the registration of the team to be invalid.**

#### **6. Can team members be changed after registration is completed?**

Yes, changing of team members can be made after registration. There will be an administration fee of S\$10.00 for every substitution made before and on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2010. Substitutions can still be made on 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> May 2010 (3 days before) and on 16<sup>th</sup> May 2010 (event day). However, an administration fee of S\$20.00 will be charged for every substitution made.

#### **7. How do I know if my team is registered for the race?**

Every team member will be notified via email or call within 2 weeks upon submission of registration. The teams that are in the race will also be published on <http://xphysique.ntusportsclub.sg> upon confirmation.

\*Teams which are not successfully registered for the race will be made known to the team members via email or call and a full refund will be made.

#### **8. Will I be able to get a refund if my team pulls out of the race?**

No refunds will be made once the team is successfully registered.

#### **9. What happens if a teammate is unable to make it on the event day?**

If no replacement is made, the team will still be able to participate but will not be able to qualify for any prizes.

If replacement is made, the team will be able to participate, will be qualified for the prizes, but will have to pay S\$20.00 for administration fees.

\*Note: The person as the replacement will not be covered by our insurance.
